# COVID-19 guidance

Effective September 26 Good Shepherd Lutheran Church (GSLC) will follow Fairfax County Government COVID-19 guidelines. These will apply to all employees, members, and visitors participating in indoor activities including worship, Christian education, youth activities, meetings, and office work. General information can be found at: <u>https://www.fairfaxcounty.gov/covid-19-information-portal</u>.

The current guidelines mandate masks for everyone, regardless of vaccination status. GSLC will make an exception for worship officiants while speaking from the chancel, musicians while singing from the choir loft, and worshippers when partaking in communion. Office workers may remove their mask when along in a private office. Masks may also be removed for eating and drinking in the building. Separate seating areas in the sanctuary for unvaccinated worshippers will be discontinued.

Although not mandatory, the guidelines recommend physical distancing (6 feet), frequent handwashing, and staying home when ill.

Community Service and COVID-19. Active COVID protocols will be followed in most cases and are subject to change.
