Adult Bible Study: The "Letters of John" - Starting Sunday, September 19, 2021 at 11:30 a.m., we will start a Bible Study via Zoom. The certainty of Christian people is twofold: objective (that the Christian religion is true) and subjective (that they have been born of God and possess eternal life). Both are expounded by John, who takes it for granted that this double assurance is right and healthy. In the Letters of John (by John Stott - one of the world's leading and most-loved Bible teachers ) we will study the nature of these certainties and the grounds on which they are built.
